artist statement

Born in 1988 in Tehran, Reihaneh Hosseini lives and works in Vienna.

Raised in Tehran, Iran, Reihaneh studied Philosophy before she emigrated to Vienna in 2014, where she currently resides. Trained under Austrian abstract artists including Christian Schwarzwald and Gunter Damisch, Reihaneh soon returned to figurative painting, her favored style that allows her to reflect on the world that surrounds her. As a storyteller, she is inspired by her friends and everyday life experiences, yet she portrays them with a dysmorphic rendition, exaggerated proportions, grotesque and distorted features, and an incongruous palette. Her strong sense of corporeality coupled with the absurdity of the scenes that she depicts, reveals a psycho-emotional approach to life and painting. The figures that populate her works oscillate between beauty and ugliness, they have a cartoonish appearance that adds a glimpse of humor and playfulness to her compositions. Reihaneh's paintings take us to a dreamlike world where each of her characters evoke our unconscious thoughts, our inner child as well as our mental and social imagery.

Reihaneh recently completed her MFA at the Academy of Fine Art in Vienna, Austria. She has exhibited and is featured in private collections in Europe, North America and the Middle East. She was included in a group exhibition at Ross+Kramer in New York, in June-July 2021. Recent projects and collaborations will lead to exhibitions in the US, Europe and Asia in 2022-2023. Reihaneh Hosseini was selected as part of the Art Maze Issue 24, curated by Harpers Gallery in New York City.
